SEEDLING DIG UP RULES

We are very fortunate to be able to remove seedlings for our use, free of charge.

One of the conditions for removal of seedlings is that we take <u>as</u>

<u>little soil as possible</u> from the orchard. Seedlings are to be 'bare root' when they leave the orchard. This does not hurt the tree while it is still in dormancy.

In order to facilitate this we recommend that those who are digging, gently remove the soil from the roots and place it back into the hole. Wrap the roots in wet burlap or newspaper (that you will need to bring with you) and either plant as soon as possible or store in a cool location.

Please respect the 'bare root' request or we may not be able to have 'dig ups' at the orchard in the future.
